DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO APPLY

- Application form filled.
- One photograph jpg format
- Proof of identity (identity card, passport, valid residence permit)
- A letter of motivation with relevant information
- Transcript of records of previous years completed at your home institution.
- Proof of Spanish language level (minimum required B1 level)
- Portfolio or book (PDF file) with referenced pictures of the student's work (15 MB max)

ESCOLA MASSANA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ADMISSIONS WHEN

- The application form and the portfolio arrive after the deadline, May 1st.
- The home institution number of applications exceeds the agreed maximum number of exchanges in the Academic Year
- The number of applications for the Department exceeds places available for exchange students. In this case, Escola Massana would choose applicants whose portfolio presents the most interesting works.
- The portfolio contains not enough information to evaluate student's work, or Escola Massana considers the student's work and academic standing to be inappropriate.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Applicants will be selected based on their portfolio quality.

ACCEPTANCE

Accepted students will receive a letter of acceptance before 15th July. Home institution will be informed at the same time as the student.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Classes are taught either in Catalan or Spanish. The usage of either language depends on the teacher who gives the course. There are not classes taught in English.
